

Construction notification: New one-way streets and George Spicer School Street

Dear Resident, Parent or Business Owner,

We recently wrote to you regarding proposed changes to the George Spicer Primary School Street. Following the consultation (TG1508), the decision has been made to implement a new one-way system and an extension of the existing School Street timed closure zone to include part of Craddock Road.

We are implementing these changes in the area in response to feedback received from residents and they will improve the flow of traffic along the roads around the school. They will also improve safety for children, parents and others in the area by preventing vehicles from entering the School Street zone via the adjoining roads.

The new one-way streets and changes to the Schools Street timed closure zone are outlined in the table below and shown in the enclosed plan.

New one-way roads	 Craddock Road, Mafeking Road and Kimberley Gardens will each become one-way streets between Southbury Road and Sketty Road. The one-way system on these roads will be in operation full time The new one-way roads will become effective from when the road markings are in place and the signage unveiled. Please see below regarding the expected construction dates
Changes to the School Street timed closure zone	 The existing School Street timed closure of Sketty Road will remain. This is operational Monday to Friday, during school term times from 8.30am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm. The times are displayed on signs at each end of the closure zone when the School Street timed closure is operational. People who drive a motor vehicle into the zone during the hours of operation without a permit will receive a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). The existing School Street timed closure zone will soon be extended to include the section of Craddock Road between Southbury Road and Sketty Road. This will mean that during the hours of the School Street zone including Sketty Road and Craddock Road without a permit.

 Permits are now available to residents and businesses within the area marked on the map attached. Information on how to apply can be found below. We will write to residents again to inform you of when the camera enforcement on Craddock Road will go live, and therefore when this closure point becomes operational. The existing School Street timed closure on Sketty Road remains in place and is operational on
Mondays to Fridays during term times from 8.30am to 9.15am and
2.45pm to 3.45pm.

When will work be starting?

Construction work will be starting on Monday 14th November 2022 and is anticipated to last for two to three weeks. This will include:

- the installation of new signage and updating road markings
- installing an Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) camera on Craddock Road at the junction with Southbury Road.

The existing School Street timed closure on Sketty Road will continue to operate throughout the works.

Permits

Residents who live and businesses who operate within the School Street zone on Sketty Road and Craddock Road as shown in the map enclosed are eligible for permits. Residents who live in and businesses who operate on Mafeking Road and Kimberley Gardens are also eligible for permits. These are free and can be applied for now at

<u>https://www.enfield.gov.uk/services/parking/parking-permits-rb</u>. If you have not applied for a permit previously then you will need to set up an account in order to apply. If you already have a permit for the existing School Street timed closure, you do not need to re-apply – your existing permit will apply to both ANPR cameras.

We understand that construction works of this nature can cause some disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience caused. We and our contractor work hard to ensure we minimise any disruption where possible whilst the works are undertaken. Signage will be put out to notify you of temporary suspension of parking bays to enable works. Please visit the project page at https://letstalk.enfield.gov.uk/SchoolStreets for more information.


